Atonement is a “growing church.” Since our momentous decision to relocate, we have been slowly but steadily growing for 12 years! Our Children and Family ministry has more than doubled and worship attendance has grown by 46%.



We are also “growing” church. Here are a few examples;

- More than 50% of our adult worshipers are active participants in small groups.

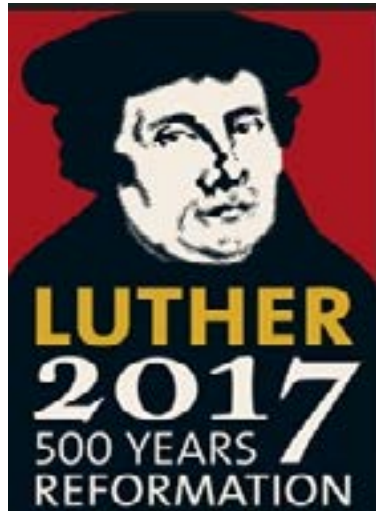

Bible Smugglers is an interactive theater game produced by Morning Star Productions, a Christian theater company in Milwaukee.

This interactive event will take place at Wooded Hills Church in Richfield, Wisconsin.

We're turning the woods behind the church into England in the 1500's. The "audience" will be given a mission: go into the world of William Tyndale, find a contact, locate a Bible written in English, and smuggle it out without being stopped by the authorities.

A CARTHAGE CHRISTMAS

**“From Heaven Above
to Earth You Come”**

DEC. 1-3, 2017

Carthage College invites the community to celebrate the joy of the holiday season at the annual Christmas Festival in the A. F. Siebert Chapel. The concert theme, “From Heaven Above to Earth You Come”, is taken from a Christmas carol written by Martin Luther in 1534. For more than 20 years, these annual concerts have been the College’s Christmas gift to the community.

Featuring the sounds of the majestic Fritsch Memorial Organ, the Carthage Christmas Festival follows an age-old tradition of sharing the celebration of the birth of Christ through readings and music.

The festival includes Carthage’s annual Service of Light, when the chapel is filled with candlelight. Each performance features students in the Carthage Choir, Carthage Women’s Ensemble, Lincoln Chamber Singers, Carthage Chorale, Wind Orchestra, and other instrumental ensembles, as well as students from the Theatre Department.

This year’s Christmas Festival will be the culmination of a yearlong celebration of the 500th Anniversary of Martin Luther’s posting of his 95 Theses. Carthage has commissioned composer Jocelyn Hagen and poet Michael Dennis Browne to create a new work incorporating themes of Martin Luther’s carol.
